- Aspen Gardens 2-day camp ~9:00am 3:30pm, week of July 29-August 2 (exact dates and times to be confirmed)
- Aspen Gardens 2-day camp week of August 26-30 (exact dates and times to be confirmed)

The coach will be compensated for \$15.00/hour that they volunteer with us during the summer camps.

Key Responsibilities:

- Coach their specific sport to two different groups of girls. One group will be for ages 5-8 and the other will be ages 9-12. The duration of each group is about 45 minutes
- Plan age appropriate lessons for the girls that are fun and engaging
- If you are representing a sports organization then we ask you to bring your own equipment. If you cannot bring your own equipment or need us to supplement it then we need to know at least three weeks in advance.
